School-

Security: The School Board is considering a proposal to bring in several "Class 3" police officers to provide security. These officers must be retired NJ police officers over the age of 55. They will be hired by the township and report to the head of the police department. Comments were that all costs must be recovered from the school

Budget: Dave reported on this year's school budget. Funding for the new track is there and the total budget is up \$1.3M (5.27%) over last year.

Police Move: Draft architectural plans are in, sally port included. Waiting for detailed plans.

Trash/Recycling/Cleanup: Proposal to use private hauler to bring in and pick up dumpsters is being bid out. Concerns about safety, cost, and wind-blown debris need to be addressed.

WAT Road Plan: 5 yr road plan from DPW was distributed and discussed. Comment about requesting more detail in the out years.

Property Tax-Charitable Deduction: Discussion regarding NJ plan to allow property taxes to be reclassified as charitable deductions. Consensus was to wait and see how the NJ legislation is treated by the IRS before making any decisions.
