Sustainable Jersey Certification

March

The Environmental Commission/Green Team was notified that West Amwell had achieved Sustainable Jersey certification at the bronze level in program year 2011.

June – September

Sustainable Jersey Small Grants

May-June

Discussions of grant application for conservation easements. Contact with Banisch Associates. Grant applied for in July.

Amendment to the Renewable Energy Ordinance

June

The EC reviewed and discussed at length the issue of cadmium telluride and made recommendations to Planning Board to not prohibit these panels.

Sustainable Jersey Small Grants

September – Dec.

In September the Environmental Commission/Green Team was notified by Sustainable Jersey that West Amwell had been selected to receive their Small Grant for \$10,000 for Conservation Easements.

In October the Open Space chair met with the EC to discuss the grant. Both Chairs met with Banisch Associates in October. In November the EC chair met with the Open Space Committee and subsequently met with their sub-committee to continue work on the grant.

2008 NRI Update

November – December

The NRI was updated to reflect the most current land use/land cover data from the DEP. The State Plan and Sourland Special Resource Area were removed and the Invasives/Alternatives were added to the Appendix. Other minor changes were made.
