Paul said that the glass on the sign was going to be replaced by the scout, although he's not sure why or whether it would be all three glass panels.

Paul will speak to VFW about attending the veteran's day event.

Martha suggesting we have a wreath for the vent. Paul will look into typical measurements. Martha will draft a program and the bio info from the veterans that perished in the war and are starred on the sign

Linda will contact the SHRHS band instructor to see if any student buglers could play at the event.

Linda will ask Rob Tomenchok about the status of the monies leftover from the project, and if the glass will be weather-proof for the additional sign.
