OLD BUSINESS

Farmland Preservation Projects:

Runkle's Farm: Mr. Shute reported that the Runkles have to make a correction on the deed.

<u>Fulper</u>: Mr. Shute provided maps of the south side of the property to the Committee members and went over the map. The Committee engaged in a discussion on this property. The map depicted a portion of the property being public access and the remainder being preserved. Mr. Fulper would like a buffer between the house and the public access portion. The following was discussed: the pros and cons for the Township, cost of preservation, whether or not hunting would be allowed, access to the property, exception area, and funding of the project if approved. Mr. Bergenfeld and Mr. Shute will talk to Mr. Fulper.

Other:

<u>Hunting Program</u>: Ms. Urbanski and Mr. Malek worked on "housekeeping corrections" on the bylaws for the hunting program. They will be put on the website.

<u>Wooden Property:</u> Mr. Cronce looked at the deed and spoke to the attorney. West Amwell controls 63.3 percent of the property. There is no horseback riding per ordinance. There is hunting on the property from September through February. D&R wants to allow. Per the D&R 2013 management plan horseback riding is not allowed. Mr. Cronce will speak to the Township attorney for his opinion. Erosion from horses was mentioned.

Website: Ms. Urbanski said the website was okay.

<u>By-Laws:</u> The Committee by-laws were amended to change the Committee to six members. Ms. Urbanski reported that the by-laws are up to date.
