Don't Be a Wishful, (Misinformed) Recycler!

Not all Plastics are recyclable – when in doubt, throw it out! Accepted symbols 22 & 23 ONLY!



## Only properly prepped CLEAN materials can be recycled, the rest is GARBAGE!

Improperly prepared recycling products contaminate the load, forcing otherwise useful material to go to a landfill, hence driving recycling costs up because disposal now happens twice.

These common 'Wishful' Recycle items are actually GARBAGE and should be disposed as regular Trash:

- 1. Pizza Boxes
- 2 **Plastic Drink Cups, Lids and Straws**
- 3. **Packing Mailers with Bubble Wrap Inside**
- 4. ANY Packaging that combines Cardboard and Plastics or Metals (UNLESS SEPARATED)
- **ANY Materials Contaminated with Food or Moisture** 5.
- **Anything Rubber** 6.
- 7. Plastic Film/Wrap, Plastic Bags, Plastic Toys
- Plastic Food 'clam-shell' Containers 8.
