

SPECIAL WEST AMWELL TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE MEETING

June 15, 2010 – 4:00 p.m.

The West Amwell Township Committee met on the above date at 4:01 p.m. Present: Mayor Molnar, and Committeeman Fisher. Committeeman Masterson was out of town. Also in attendance were Attorney Faherty, Judge Barson, Court Administrator Hoagland and Zach Rich.

In compliance with the Public Meetings Act, Mayor Molnar announced that this Special Meeting was called pursuant to the provisions of the Open Public Meetings Act with notices faxed to the Hunterdon County Democrat and the Trenton Times on June 9, 2010. A copy of this notice is and has been available to the public and is on file in the office of the Municipal Clerk.

The meeting was recorded via digital recording system and a copy of the CD is on file in the Office of the Municipal Clerk.

BUDGET WORKSHOP – COURT:

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss options and direction for the remainder of the year as the amount budgeted for the prosecutor has been exhausted. Under consideration were 1) cutting the number of court sessions; 2) deferring payment to the prosecutor until funds can be transferred in November; or, 3) amending the introduced budget. After considerable discussion and review of the available options and ramifications of each, Attorney Faherty offered to defer prosecutor billing until November. This action was accepted by the Township Committee and appreciation extended to all concerned for their assistance and input.

OPEN TO THE PUBLIC:

A list of outstanding projects was reviewed. Some were designated as agenda items for the next meeting while others need more investigation and/or additional information.

ADJOURNMENT:

There being no further business, the meeting was unanimously adjourned at 5:07 p.m. on motion by Molnar, seconded by Fisher.
